26. brief description (note unusual features, integrity, environment, threats and associated buildings) <p>This building represents a 4 Over 4 type vernacular house. The 2 story, rectangular shaped structure has a wood frame and original weather board wall finish. The 5 bays contain 6-over-6 sash windows. The gable roof is supported by double sets of brackets. The four interior end chimneys are brick covered with stucco. The corner porch is partially recessed into the facade. A small wing and back porch are additions to the original design. The corner porch posts and balustrade have also been replaced. Several of the original windows have been replaced with new windows of similar design.</p> <p>This property is zoned R-2, Residential and located in a Community Development Target Area.</p>																																		
27. history, significance and/or background Information gathered from several historical maps indicates that this house was built between 1861 and 1876. The property owner's name appears on the 1876 Atlas Map as "S.McBryar". The original 4 Over 4 design of this vernacular house is easily recognizable and the building could be restored. The 4 Over 4 folk type was built throughout Armstrong County in the mid-19th Century. The structure represents the best example of this style found in Apollo Borough. Its original use as a residence has been maintained.
