26. brief description (note unusual features, integrity, environment, threats and associated buildings) <p>This rectangular-shaped dwelling is a good example of the Bungalow style. Its gabled roof extends over the wide front porch and is interrupted by a front-facing dormer and one brick interior chimney. 1/1 sash windows are used throughout the brick, 1-1/2 story house. These windows are arranged in sets of two, three, or four with louvered shutters on the dormer set. Brick flat-arch decor tops the window heads. The entranceway, in the center of the three bay facade, has sidelights and a wood panel transom. The wood front door has three long narrow glass panes. Brick piers and a solid brick rail frame the front and back porches. The addition of new aluminum siding to the dormer and porch roof gables has been the only alteration. A wood garage is located at the rear of the lot. This property is zoned R-1, Single Family Residential. There are no threats known to the structure.</p>

27. history, significance and/or background <p>This fine example of Bungalow style architecture was built in 1926, during the period when this style was most popular. Many bungalows were built in North Apollo Borough during the decade 1920-1930. The citizens of this expanding area organized in the 1920s and the Borough was incorporated in 1930. This bungalow, built as a single-family residence, has had only minor alterations and could be restored.</p>
