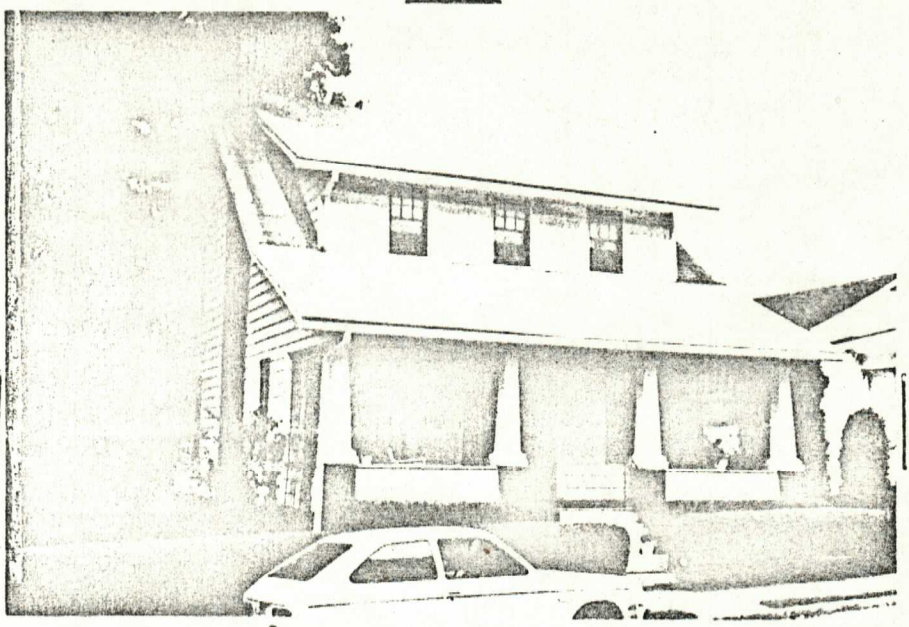
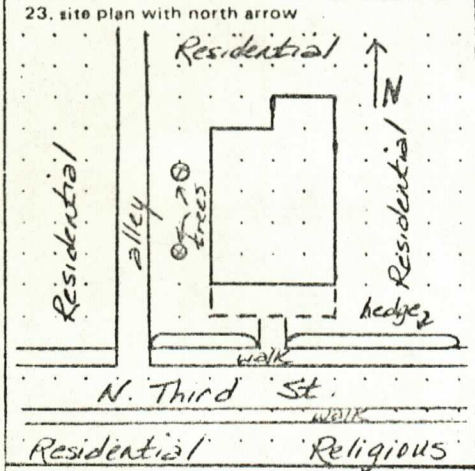

26. brief description (note unusual features, integrity, environment, threats and associated buildings) This 1-1/2 story dwelling exhibits typical Bungalow style features. The gable roofline is interrupted by one brick exterior chimney and a wide shed dormer. There is a small rear wing on the rectangular-shaped main section. Two sash windows flank the entranceway on the three-bay facade. These windows have vertical muntins separating five panes in the top sash. Similar windows were used throughout the exterior walls and dormer. Side lights flank the original wood doorway. The front porch has tapered posts supported on stone piers and a solid balustrade. The addition of aluminum siding to the wood frame has been the only exterior alteration. This house is located in a Community Development Target Area of Apollo Borough and zoned R-2, Residential. There are no threats known to the structure.

27. history, significance and/or background This house is a good example of Bungalow style architecture, popular from 1890 to 1940. At least twenty-five bungalows were built in Apollo Borough in the 1920s and 1930s. This house was built in 1930 as a single-family residence. Restoration would be possible since the single alteration to the original design has been the addition of aluminum siding. The window design used, with long narrow panes in a top sash over a single light bottom sash, is found throughout Armstrong County. It was used extensively on Bungalow style, Cubic style and (over)
