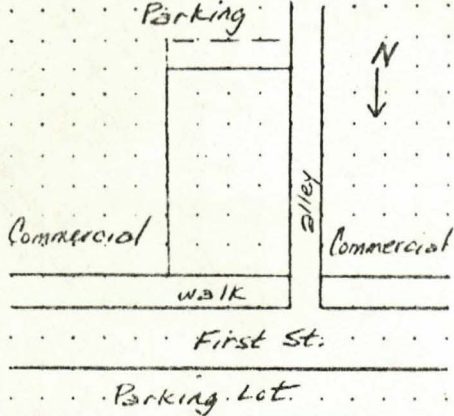

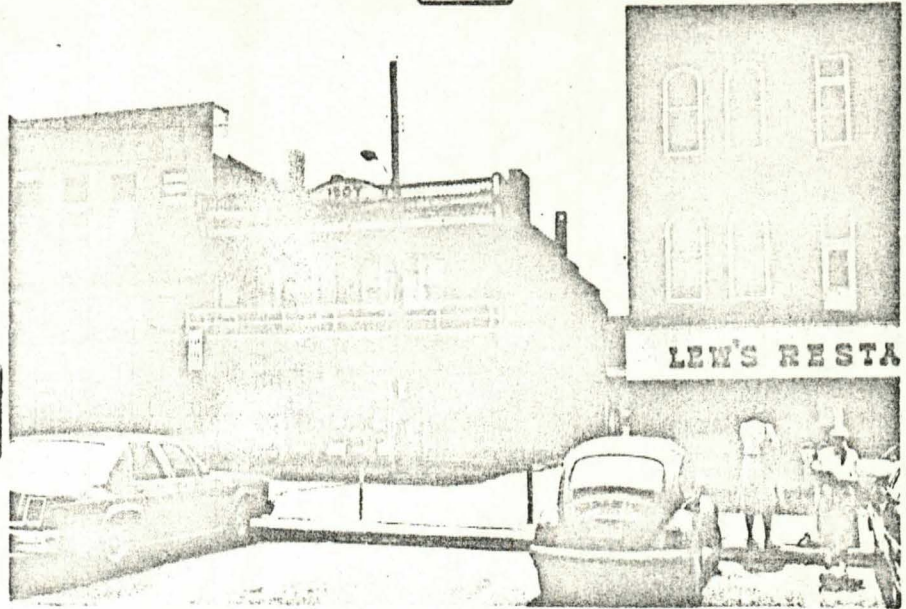

26. brief description (note unusual features, integrity, environment, threats and associated buildings) THIS turn-of-the-century two-story Commercial building features two original storefronts with large display windows and recessed doorways. A frieze board tops the storefronts and a wooden pilaster ornaments the left front display window. This rectangular-shaped, flat-roofed building has one rear interior brick chimney and two side exterior chimneys. The second story has a facade door and full length balcony. Two tripart elliptical arched windows with central stained-glass transoms decorate the second story facade, segmental brick arches crown these windows. A decorative wood cornice and balustrade with a central date plate tops the facade. A rear one-story frame wing and second story porch were later additions. The facade balcony is also an alteration. This building is located within Apollo's business district and is zoned B-1, General Business. There are no known threats to this building.

27. history, significance and/or background The Hilty's Store building features the only remaining unaltered storefront in Apollo Borough's Business district. The building exemplifies the early 20th Century Commercial style. Originally owned by the Devers family, the building has maintained its original commercial use. Minor alterations to the structure could be easily removed and the building restored to its original appearance. The structure was constructed one year after the Leechburg and Apollo Electric Railway began operations.
